## **AUTHOR CHECKLIST**

Procedure for submissions: Submissions can include original papers, debate, articles, reports, reviews, commendations and obituaries. All contributions should be submitted via email to the journal's Editors-in-Chief (Lorna Robinson, Kate Thompson, James Poulton). Please see detailed instructions below.

Confidentiality and consent: In keeping with PEP guidelines, C&FP require all contributors to implement reliable anonymisation of any and all case material. Authors whose papers include accounts of clinical work are required to take all necessary measures to ensure that none of the individuals written about can be identified by any third party and to fully minimise the likelihood that the patient(s) will recognise him/her/themself. Authors are expected to keep careful, discrete records about their specific and detailed undertakings to anonymise case material. This can be done through thorough disguise or the use of composites or by following relevant guidelines given by professional bodies in the field.

The anonymisation policy should not hide what might be important features of a patient's life and experience in a way detrimental to future understanding, and the removal (or insertion) of details to achieve anonymisation should be carefully thought through in the light of unconscious assumptions that may be being made and their effect on any potential conclusions to be drawn from a paper. If requiring further advice, authors are invited to discuss these matters with a member of the Journal's International Advisory Board in their country.

Authors: Please verify that you have anonymised all case material, and describe in your own words the steps you have taken to do so:
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1. Have you reviewed the Final Checklist for Phoenix journal articles to ensure your submission follows house style? 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  - a. This form "Author Checklist" with all questions answered and your signature attesting that all clinical material in your submission (if any) has been fully anonymised. Either scan the form into a pdf file, or photograph all pages with a smart phone.
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  - c. An abstract up to 200 words in length on a separate page. Include Keywords with the abstract.
  - d. Your paper, excluding any indications of your identity (see #10 above).

You will receive confirmation via return email that your submission has been received.
