We encourage submissions for the designated sections of the journal:

1. Clinical papers:
Advancing the field of attachment-based relational psychotherapy and contemporary psychoanalytic psychotherapy. These clinical papers are reviewed by the editorial team and should aim to have a clear clinical message supported, where appropriate, by theory and relevant referenced literature. Selected papers may be considered for formal peer review.
2. Original and research papers:
Advancing the field of attachment-based psychological therapies from all clinical disciplines. These papers are formally peer-reviewed. A second blind copy must be provided.
3. Book and Creative Literature Reviews:
Short reviews of books, films, poetry are accepted. Please visit the website for further guidance.

Manuscript submission

Contributions should be 4,000 to 8,000 words incl refs. We also accept shorter reports, reviews of literature/arts from 1,000-3,000 words. Full guidelines for authors including submission instructions can be found at:
